BARN

- Please help us save money and conserve energy by closing doors completely and turning off unnecessary lights.
- Please pick up any manure your horse leaves in the aisle or washrack.
- Sweep the entire cross-tie area that you use before you ride and after you put your horse up for the day.
- Please put back any brushes, hoof picks, saddle pads, polo wraps, shampoo, tack cleaner, etc., that you use.
- Put dirty laundry in the laundry basket in the feed room or in the laundry room.
- Use caution when navigating the cross-ties. Ask someone to help you get by if there is a horse in the way.
- Guests must stay in designated spectator areas, which are the clubroom and outside viewing areas. If guests wish to tour the aisle or paddocks, they must sign a waiver first.

ARENA

- Please pay attention to any lessons going on while you are hacking, and stay out of the way as best you can. ☺
- Jumping is allowed only in the presence of a trainer or instructor.
- Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
- No one may sit on any horse under any circumstances without first signing a liability waiver. This includes all relatives of boarders and students as well as any friends, teachers, etc., who may come to visit.
- DO NOT TALK ON YOUR CELL PHONE WHILE RIDING IN THE RING.

SCHEDULING

- All tack-ups must be scheduled at least one day in advance. This will help us organize the turnout schedule, the grooms' work schedule, and also the arena schedule so that the ring doesn't get too crowded at certain times.
- There will be a charge for all lessons that are cancelled less than 24 hours in advance.

CLUBROOM

- Before you leave, please throw out all your drinks, bottles, cans, food, food wrappers, containers, and bags, as well as all other types of trash and unused horse treats.
- Please store your personal belongings in your locker.
- No food in lockers!!!
- Do not climb on furniture, saddle racks, etc. If your child cannot follow this rule, please leave him/her at home.

PROPERTY

- Your dog is not allowed on the property at any time. This is the insurance company's rule, not mine.
- No smoking is allowed on the property at any time.
- Don't ride on the septic field between the two outdoor rings. It has a trench through it that could hurt your horse badly. Also it is too soft to weather the impact of horses at work.
- Do not climb on or play in and/or around machinery, piles of stuff (dirt, sand, limestone), dumpsters, hay storage, jumps, fencing, drains, ditches, walls, or other structures at the farm. They are not toys and can be very dangerous if treated as such. You will be responsible for the cost of replacing anything you may break as a result of such prohibited actions.
