

# Board & Services at Palladia Farm

## LESSONS & TRAINING

30-minute lesson: \$50 (\$45 for boarders)  
45-minute lesson: \$75 (\$70 for boarders)  
Riding School: \$500 per session  
Training Ride: \$50 for Margaret; \$75 for Doug

Hack on a school horse: \$35/ride  
Shareboard: \$600/month  
Commission on sale/lease: 15%

## MONTHLY BOARD: \$850/month board + supply fee + extra charges

### Board Includes:

- 10x10, 10x15 or 10x20 heated stall
- Stalls picked twice daily
- High-quality hay fed 3-4 times per day
- Customized grain program fed 2-4 times per day
- Daily grooming and health care
- Daily turnout
- Daily tack cleaning
- Blanketing, handwalking, bandaging
- Ear and muzzle clipping, mane pulling, mane training, etc.
- Tack-up service for all weekday hacks and lessons
- Tack-up service for weekend hacks and lessons when needed. (Students are strongly encouraged to groom and handle their own horses on the weekends when they are likely to have more time, as this should be an enjoyable and educational activity.)
- Storage, administration and management of all supplements and medicines
- Coordination of farrier, dental, chiropractic, and veterinary programs for your horse
- A secure locker in our clubroom area that you can use to store your things

### Supply Fee:

Pays for tack cleaner, conditioner, fly spray, Showsheen, shampoo, schooling saddle pads, polo wraps, pillow wraps, standing wraps, furacin, DMSO, poultice, liniments, electrolytes, routine medications, sheet cotton, kendall cotton, vetrap, etc. Every month our inventory will be replenished and the cost will be divided evenly among all boarders.

### Extra Charges:

- Body clipping: \$100 as needed, usually every other month
- Treadmill and/or GameReady Therapy: \$100/month
- Dewormers and vaccinations will be acquired and administered by Palladia Farm staff in consultation with our veterinarians. These will be billed to clients as used.
- Sedation for riding, clipping, treatment of injuries, etc., is billed as needed
- Blanket cleaning and repair, invoiced on behalf of our service provider for your convenience
- Halter and tack repair, invoiced on behalf of our service provider for your convenience
- Expanded health care: \$15/hour for all medical care that your horse requires BEYOND the first two hours each day. For example, if your horse requires 5 hours of daily care, your cost is \$45/day—the first 2 hours are included, and the additional three are billed separately.

## HORSE SHOWS AND TRAVELING

- \$125/day fee per horse at shows—includes stall cleaning, feeding, wrapping, lunging, routine medications, bathing, tack ups, grazing, and equipment. This fee also covers training and coaching received from your trainer as well as overtime paid to the grooms. Tipping the grooms and/or your trainer is no longer mandatory, though it is appreciated when received.
- Professional rides: \$75/class
- \$250/day special event fee. If a Palladia Farm staff member travels with you or your horse to a special event (e.g., an appointment at a veterinary clinic, a special horse show that only you attend, or a trip to try prospective horses), you will be assessed this fee. This fee compensates the staff member for their time, and reimburses Palladia Farm, Inc., for income not earned while traveling.
